FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"And he said to them, 'Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation..." (Luke 16:15)

After the euphoria of Easter morning and Jesus' miraculous resurrection, Jesus appeared to his disciples and followers several times to convince them that, yes, he really was risen and alive. The disciples found themselves in an in-between time of believing and seeing and then wondering just how they were to do what Jesus asked of them, "To go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation."

And here we are here, in this in-between, post-Easter time, and like the disciples, still trying to wrap our minds around the resurrection of Jesus and what it means for us and how we are to live in this changing time.

Jesus tells us simply, "to go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation." And he tells us, "To feed my lambs, to tend my sheep, to feed my sheep."

Three times Jesus asked Peter, "Do you love me?" Three times, Peter grieved by his past and pained by the question, responded, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Three times, through word and deed, Jesus releases Peter from his shame and guilt and reminds him of his call: "Feed my sheep. Tend my flock." Jesus fed him. He forgave him. He called him. Just as he feeds us, forgives us and calls us.

We are to joyfully share the good news of Jesus Christ and his love to all and to care for one another, and for those whom he gives to us in the community of Canton and throughout the world. Let us live into the good news of this Easter season, by staying faithful to our call, our vision, to serving our Lord, in all the ways we are called and gifted, even as we await the promise of the coming of God's Holy Spirit and eventually a new pastor.

This is a time for rejoicing, for living the good news of Easter, and to stay ever faithful, knowing that our risen Lord feeds us, forgives us and sets us free to serve.

May we look for the presence of the risen and living Lord among us and as he comes to us in our daily lives, in the faces of those around us, in the caring that we offer, in the hands that serve and in the showing of love in which we are so loved by God. This time, this post-Easter, in-between, already and not yet time, is a gift to prepare you for the new life, the new things God is bringing to you and to be through you.


